The purpose of this engagement is to share fundamentals of the draft Land Use Bylaw and gather feedback before the bylaw is finalized.

Council has drafted a new Land Use Bylaw to replace the current Land Use Bylaw that dates back to 1993. Alberta's Municipal Government Act requires every municipality in the province to have a LUB for regulating development. The LUB guides all development applications and permit processes and regulates the use of land within the community. The new LUB follows the same land use districting framework as the current LUB with improvements to language, reorganization and streamlining of existing sections and the new required regulations under the MGA.

Project team members from Parkland Community Planning Services and Council members will be in attendance to answer your questions and listen to your thoughts.
